December 1849, Deed between George Patrick, miller and Frederick Alexander of two windmills and going gears relating to First Mill and Little Mill. 28 inches by 21 on vellum. **£45**

Kenneth Farries' Essex Windmills Volume 5 page 52 refers to Thorpe Mills and the Patrick Family.

**3 Haconby** February 1670, on vellum. A large indenture between Michael Myles, miller and John Wright miller concerning a windmill at Haconby. Size 23 in. by 20 in. **£30**

**4 Helpringham** November 1789, two page bond of John Watkin miller relating to a windmill and appurtenances. **£30**

**5 Horbling** October 1803, Bond of property including a corn windmill with their appurtenances in occupation of John Bramley. Folio paper. **£30**

**6 South Witham** August 1685, A one year lease between Thomas Bull, Millwright and Richard Tailor, Yeoman. Describes in detail the land holding surrounding the cottage Very decorative with two seals on vellum 14 in. By 12 in. **£38**

**7 Rippingdale** March 1875, Indenture Partnership Eliz. Chapman widow and John Spapleton, miller and Stephen Stapleton farmer. Running the windmill and premises in Rippingdale. Also document dissolving the partnership. On Vellum 24 in. by 19 in. **£30**

#### 7 Sutterton

Two windmill documents March 1927. Account of repairs required by Mr. Grumble to be done by Mr William Moses the owner. Dated March 1827. Two new sails, mill steps and a pair of French stones are mentioned. A very rare pair of documents. **£45**

Lincolnshire Windmills by Rex Wailes, and Peter Dolman book of the same title do not mention these mills in any detail.
